

Time approx 10 mins  
Difficulty rating – Low/ medium  
Before Starting you will need:  
4mm allen key

1. Slide rear steering unit off fork by pressing Quick Release pin and sliding upwards



2. Compress headset/fork assembly and tighten Fork Clamp with 4mm allen key.

**Be careful not to over-tighten fork clamp, hand tight is sufficient. Ensure the fork spins freely but there is no play in the bearings before reattaching the steering unit**




Also, you may find it easier to use a clamp and piece of tube to compress the bearings before tightening.



3. Slide Steering unit back onto fork by compressing Quick Release pin and locating in slot securely

•make sure rear fork is 'trailing' i.e. pointing to the rear of the trike. Also make sure steering cables are tight by loosening clamp bolts and pulling cable through with pliers before re-clamping
